This fall, the American Grassfed Association, Holistic Management International, and Quivira Coalition will continue our collaboration to convene ranchers, farmers, and land stewards of all stripes.

Like last year, the 2022 REGENERATE conference will be held as a hybrid event, with opportunities for virtual and in-person engagement, in order to improve accessibility and increase the number of people who are able to attend and engage. The REGENERATE season will again span September through November, hosting virtual workshops and field days across the West on topics like erosion control, rotational grazing, direct marketing, equitable land access, social justice in agriculture, and more. These sessions will last until November 2-4, when land stewards can tune into or attend a two-day event full of roundtable discussions and plenaries regarding regenerative agriculture.
